Visitors were able to record what they had seen of interest and here are some of the quotes.

A green Cayuga duck (domestic) was seen on 17th February 2010

A female great-crested newt was seen to be laying eggs on 8th April 2010

Some children reported seeing a Canada Goose sitting on eggs.

A Little Grebe was a highlight for another young visitor.

The tally of birds seen is now 82 since 2002 which includes a Red Kite seen in November 2010 and a Jack Snipe seen in December 2010.
